SHINE!

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, [God's] own purchased, special people, that you may set forth the wonderful deeds and display the virtues and perfections of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light (1 Peter 2:9 AMPC).

First, notice the tenses in the phrase: “*But ye are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation...*” This doesn’t suggest something futuristic: it’s not a promise. It refers to who you are now! You’re a chosen race; you’re dedicated to God. That means you’re sanctified unto Him for glory and for beauty.

You’re His peculiar treasure; plus, you’re royalty. You’re born a king (Revelation 1:6). You belong in the royal family of the Monarch of the Universe. Walk in this consciousness. Kings reign; therefore, reign in life over the devil, sickness, disease, and the circumstances of life.

Our theme verse also says that we’re God’s own purchased, special people. He purchased us by the blood of Jesus (Acts 20:28) so that we may set forth His wonderful deeds and display His virtues and perfections. That staggers the mind! What a calling! It means we’re to exude and display divine excellence – we have the ability to do it.

What’s more? The Bible says He has called us into His marvelous, overwhelming light. This means we dwell in light; we’re children of light. Jesus also stated this in **Matthew 5:14: “Ye are the light of the world...”** What a blessing! What an honor! What a commission! What a calling! We’re the light of the world!

To get the full import of this truth, you have to first understand what light is. Light is that which makes manifest. Light describes. **Ephesians 5:13** says,

“**But all things that are reproved are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light.**” In other words, light shows you what’s present. It leads you and gives direction. Light brings fulfillment and joy. When you show up, darkness disappears. Darkness represents sin, sickness, death, evil, and all the negative things that are associated with Satan. Jesus said, “**...I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life**” (John 8:12).

Like Jesus, you’re the light of the world, and you have the light of life. You’ve been brought out of darkness into the supernatural life of glory. Arise and shine! Refuse to allow the works of darkness to be expressed in your life, for there’s no darkness in your life.

Can you see why your life must be so full of excellence? Everything about you must reveal light, divine elegance, and beauty. There must be a decency of the Spirit about your life because you’re an ambassador of Christ.

Matthew 5:16 says, “**Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.**” Don’t just shine; shine brightly. Let the intensity of your light dazzle and discomfit Satan, his demons, and the negative works of darkness. Let it inspire men to praise and glorify your heavenly Father as they see and experience your good works – your works of righteousness.

BORN FOR THIS: The Madagascar Teens Crusade Story



Antananarivo, the vibrant heart of Madagascar, was infused with an unusual excitement as Tiffany Sombiniaina – a Teenspiration ambassador – led a transformative Teens Crusade that brought hundreds of young people together from across the region.

What made this gathering especially remarkable was that it was spearheaded by teens and young leaders themselves, proof of a generation not waiting for permission to serve God but stepping boldly into leadership.

Long before the meeting began, the atmosphere was already charged with intense anticipation. Teens arrived with their friends, carrying hope, questions, and a deep hunger for something more, something real. Some arrived quietly, unsure of what to expect, while others came openly expectant, having heard testimonies from several who had been touched through previous exploits and experiences. Yet, every heart was united by a shared longing for truth and transformation. All came expecting an encounter, and God did not disappoint.





A Citywide Stirring of Revival

The crusade echoed beyond that physical space. For days leading up to the event, Antananarivo was saturated with vibrant publicity: posters stretching across streets, banners draped on buildings, school activations, street mobilization, and social media campaigns that ignited massive buzz across the city.

Teenagers invited classmates, shared digital flyers, and amplified the message online. By the time the crusade began, the city was already talking about it. By the time it ended, the whole nation was paying attention. Teachers, parents, and community members took note of the passion and discipline displayed by the teens, opening doors for future outreaches and partnerships.



A Supernatural Night with Healing Streams

One of the major highlights of this crusade was the rebroadcast of the October 2025 Healing Streams Live Healing Services with Pastor Chris. As it began to play, the gathering instantly shifted into a realm of divine visitation. The Word went forth with power, faith rose in the hearts of the attendees, and God's healing power swept through the venue like a mighty rushing wind.

As the man of God, Pastor Chris, ministered through the screen, the teens responded with unwavering faith, echoing confessions, praying fervently, and receiving the Word as though he were physically present among them.

Young people lifted their hands in worship, many praying in the Spirit after they received the Holy Spirit. Tears of joy streamed down many faces as the tangible love of God enveloped the arena. Teenagers who had battled sickness, depression, fear, and confusion found themselves suddenly free. The healing power of God was everywhere, touching lives deeply and permanently.

In just one night, Madagascar witnessed the awakening of a generation. Teenagers who walked into the venue unsure of their future walked out as carriers of light, truth, and divine purpose. For many, this was the first time they would publicly confess Christ, marking a defining spiritual milestone that will shape the course of their lives.

Words reveal who you are. Some teens become rude or harsh simply because they're influenced by friends who speak that way. The Bible warns us, "Don't yell at one another or curse each other or ever be rude" (Ephesians 4:31 CEV).

If your friends use cutting or unkind words, that behavior can rub off on you. On the other hand, when you stay close to friends who speak respectfully, kindly, and with wisdom, you become a stronger, gentler, and better version of

yourself. True friends help build your character, not tear it down.

④ **Friends Who Strengthen Your Faith**

Sometimes, following Jesus boldly means some friends may tease your faith, distance themselves, or pressure you to compromise. Jesus said this would happen, and He also promised we are never alone.

The wrong friends will try to pull you into worldly patterns. But the right friends will celebrate your growth in Christ, encourage your convictions, and remind you of who you are in God. They help you stand strong when challenges come. The right friends make you braver, not weaker. They help you grow, not shrink.

④ **Friends Who Help You Stay Grateful**

Life becomes much richer when you learn to appreciate the blessings God has placed around you – family, opportunities, friendships, talents, and even the simple joys of everyday life. The Bible says to give thanks in all circumstances (1 Thessalonians 5:18); gratitude is a lifestyle.

Good friends help you celebrate life. They don't complain, compete, or compare. Instead, they bring out joy, laughter, and gratitude in you. When you surround yourself with friends who value God's goodness, you cultivate a happy and thankful heart, a heart that attracts God's favor and keeps you strong in your walk with Him.

True friendship builds. It never destroys. The right friends will push you upward, call out the greatness inside you, and help you bring the blessing of God into everything you do. So, choose wisely.

- 1. Did you know the Spirit of God can give you supernatural speed?**
“Now the LORD energized Elijah with power; he tucked his robe into his belt and ran ahead of Ahab all the way to Jezreel” (1 Kings 18:46 NET).
- 2. Did you know God can suspend natural laws to help you win or recover what you lost?**
“Where did it fall in?” Elisha asked. The prophet pointed to the place, and Elisha cut a stick and threw it into the water at that spot. The ax head floated to the top of the water” (2 Kings 6:6 CEV).

“And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies...” (Joshua 10:13).
- 3. Did you know the Holy Spirit can transport you instantly to another location?**
“When they had stepped out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away. The official joyfully continued on his way and didn’t see Philip again. Philip found himself in the city of Azotus. He traveled through all the cities and spread the Good News until he came to the city of Caesarea” (Acts 8:39-40 GW).
- 4. Did you know you’re surrounded by heavenly protection?**
“God sends angels with special orders to protect you wherever you go, defending you from all harm” (Psalms 91:11 TPT).

“And Elisha prayed and said, ‘Lord, I pray, open his eyes that he may see.’ Then the Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha” (2 Kings 6:17 NKJV).
- 5. Did you know even your clothes can carry God’s healing power?**
“God gave Paul the power to work great miracles. When handkerchiefs or aprons that had touched his skin were placed on sick people, they were healed, and evil spirits went out of them” (Acts 19:11-12 CEV).
- 6. Did you know worship can break chains and open prison doors?**
“About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing praises to God, while the other prisoners listened. Suddenly a strong earthquake shook the jail to its foundations. The doors opened, and the chains fell from all the prisoners” (Acts 16:25-26 CEV).
- 7. Did you know God can multiply whatever you have when you give it to Him?**
“They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over” (Matthew 14:20 NIV).
